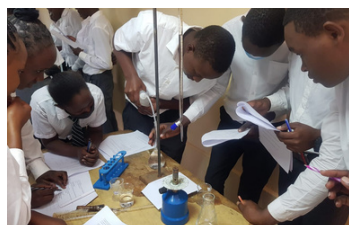


Back to school campaign 2023 - As we all settle into fall and a new school year begins, please consider sending a vulnerable child in Africa to school.

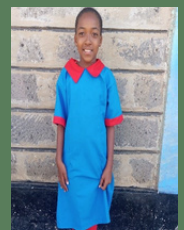
